We are very excited to announce that we have received approval in the Town of Markham's budget to get Courts 8 and 9 and 1 and 2 repaired in this upcoming season. As you may or may not know, our court repairs fees are shared between the club and the Town. We are still trying to work out dates, and have to wait until the snow melts to determine the extent of the cracking and what repairs will be needed. We realize this may cause some inconvenience and are hoping that the repairs will be done in the early fall. Courts 8 and 9 will need to be rebuilt (costing the club approx. \$20,000 each) and courts 1 and 2 will need to be assessed in the spring to determine whether they can be resurfaced or rebuilt.(approx. \$8,000 or \$20,000/court) Either way, the costs will be split over a 5 year period. We will keep you posted.

Our executive has been busy planning a great lineup of activities for Unionville Tennis Club this year. Watch for our calendar of events in the April newsletter as we

Wednesday Night Round Robin

This year Julie has passed the baton to Angel to organize this ever-popular event. Everyone at the board of directors and RR members appreciate the work that Julie did for the 2007 Round Robin program.

GameTime and its online sign up process was a real success last year. We received very favourable comments and members enjoyed the easy weekly sign up process from home. So GameTime is a keeper! We will continue to use it as the weekly sign up method. The one thing to remember is to register at the beginning of the season as only registered members can access the Round Robin GameTime Website. If you experience any problems while using GameTime, send an email to roundrobin@unionvilletennisclub.com, or contact **Angel Vera** directly.

Registration for the Round Robin is done either on Registration Day (April 5th) or by mailing the attached Round Robin registration form together with the Round Robin registration fee of \$20 to the address shown on the

form. The \$20 registration fee (GST incl.) per person is collected to help pay for the balls and the administration fee associated with the electronic sign up. This is a seasonal fee so you pay one time for the entire season which allows you to sign up each Wednesday for any one session time.

Each Wednesday there are a total of three sessions available:

- 6:30pm to 7:45pm
- 7:45pm to 9:00pm
- 9:00pm to 10:15pm

A total of 6 courts are reserved each Wednesday, but if GameTime has less people for a particular session, the reserved court is given back to the club for random play. During the mid-season, sign up was a little slow, so this year we are opening up a few more spots during the Round Robin registration. Make sure you register early as this is a very popular event and last year it was fully booked on registration day.

As always, this Round Robin is open to all UTC members of different levels but it is not suitable for new players who cannot serve or rally at least 3 consecutive times or competitive team members.

Men's Drop-in Sunday Morning

If you are one of those men that wake up at 7:30AM on Sunday and everyone is still sleeping, then you must come out to the courts and play some Tennis!

The Men's Sunday drop-in has up to five courts reserved for play starting at 8:00AM and continuing until 10:00AM. It is a non-competitive event open to all level of players except beginners. It is a self run program, so just show up at the courts sharp at 8:00AM and the monitor will help you find a court to play on.

The program starts on May 11th, weather permitting. So men, grab your best racquet and some furry balls and quietly sneak out of the house. The earlier you arrive the more you can play.

Tuesday Morning Ladies Doubles Program

This ladies program schedules one hour of game play between 9:00am to noon, every Tuesday, beginning May 6th. Three sessions will be organized during the season - Spring, Summer, and Fall. In the Spring and Summer sessions, there will be a fee of \$15 to join which covers the cost of tennis balls and includes a one hour lesson with a tennis pro in a group of four ladies to help fine-tune your tennis skills. In the Fall session, the tennis lessons are not available. Game play continues but the

fee is waived. We encourage ladies to join this program who are available and committed every Tuesday morning or can find a sub when they can't attend. In addition, due to the nature of this particular activity, it is important to note that this ladies program is not suitable for new players to the game who cannot serve or rally at least 3 consecutive times.

Registration for the Spring session will take place on registration day, April 5th. The deadline to sign-up for this program is May 2nd. Juniors Spring Program 2008: Starts week of May 5th

The cost is \$65 per 6 week program, GST included. There is a limit of 12 players/session, so sign up early to avoid disappointment.

Starter:

Lots of fun with mini nets and easy play balls. This program helps develop hand/eye coordination and racquet/ball skills through relevant games. An ideal start for the 5-8 year old.

Beginners 1/2:

This program is for players with little or no experience and introduction to the fundamentals of Tennis. Designed for players who may have had some lessons before but play has been limited. Fun games leading to rallying.

Intermediate I:

This program is for those players who have had previous lessons and can now rally with some success from the baseline. Drills and point play will be included to develop technique and footwork.

Intermediate II/Advanced: This program is for players who may be working towards Junior team play either at club or school and also for entry level tournaments. A higher level of rallying and serve is required so this is for the more experienced player looking to work on placement, use of spins and tactical play.
