Courts Update

The opening of our three clay courts has been delayed due to the wet weather we have been experiencing. We did manage to get the lines installed on Wednesday,

April 29th and expect to have the courts in play by Friday, May 1st, just in time for opening day at UTC. Courts 8 and 9 underwent major reconstruction late last fall. The final steps are the application of a fiberglass layer and a layer of paint to the asphalt surface. The final steps require nighttime temperatures to remain above 10 Degrees Celsius to ensure that the paint properly adheres to the surface. We are projecting to have courts 8 and 9 open in the 2nd week of May if the weather cooperates.

Update on Winter Tennis in Markham

Now that we have concluded that it is not possible to put a winter tennis facility on our courts, your Executive is maintaining a close watch on other alternatives in Markham.

In this connection, UTC representatives have attended two meetings arranged by the Town of Markham which included discussing the possibility of a winter tennis facility in Markham. In addition to UTC there has been representation from other local tennis clubs as well as

from local ratepayers associations and residents.

Overall there is strong support from the tennis community for a winter tennis facility in Markham – preferably a permanent structure housing 8 to 10 courts. There is also strong preference for a Town owned and operated community facility but there are significant cost challenges to achieving this in the short term. The Town is developing a “Parks, Recreation, Culture and Library Strategic Master Plan” and any expansion of tennis facilities would have to fall within the context of the Plan which is intended for finalization in the fall of 2009. Currently Markham’s available capital funds are allocated through 2031. If there is a strong desire to have a facility up and running earlier than this, the Town will likely have to consider other forms of funding including some form of private/public sharing.

The next steps will be for the Town representatives to prepare a draft report to Council discussing the options available.

UTC members who are interested in voicing their opinions are encouraged to do so through the Town Council.

We will keep you informed of developments in this regard.

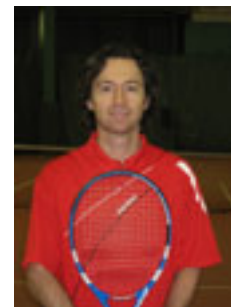

Challenge Court at UTC



1. All members welcome.
2. Challenge court will be hosted on Saturdays and Sundays on Court 1 from 1pm to 5pm.
3. If no challengers are present, Court 1 can be used for random play under the understanding that if a third challenger arrives then Court 1 will be allocated immediately for challenge play. If two people are playing random tennis, their current game or match or practice is immediately over and they must begin their challenge match immediately whether or not they are in the middle of a set or game. Their current game or set should end immediately even if it is unresolved. If a member is not willing to do this, they should **not** begin play on Court 1.
4. Procedure: write your name on White Board on Court 1 upon arrival. Erase name when you go on.
5. Take one minute warm-up. First person to win 2 games wins.
6. Winner stays on to play next challenger.
7. A winner may stay on for a maximum of 3 challenges.
8. If you lose or come off the court because you played 3 times, you may write your name up on the board again.
