Please review this with all family members. Of particular note: ***“SHOE TAGS must be visible otherwise you can be refused play”***. As a courtesy to all members, there will be a ZERO TOLERANCE policy instilled regarding shoe tags – it is only fair that all members have equal access to playing time, however non-members do not. At this time, shoe tags are a minimal cost way of ensuring you are a member so please make them visible for the monitors to see.

Please – tennis shoes only on the clay courts! ***“Members must use the court walkways, gates and clubhouse to access the courts”***. It is very disruptive to cross a court when members are playing OR members are taking a lesson with a pro. PLEASE use the pathways at ALL times to access all courts except court 1 and court 5.

To make it easier for you to determine best times to play, we have tried diligently to report court usage on the Club calendar. Each month's calendar is posted on the bulletin board in the clubhouse and on the website at <http://www.unionvilletennisclub.com/calendar.html>. Although not perfect, this can help you plan which dates and times are best so you are not left frustrated waiting for a random court. ## DID YOU KNOW

### Guest Policy

Members may introduce any number of guests (guest fee is \$5.00) during non-priority times only (guests are not permitted Monday-Thursday 7pm-11pm). All guests must complete and sign the Guest Waiver/Release Form prior to playing tennis. An individual is only eligible to be a guest 3 times in total in a given season, even if introduced by different members. After 3 visits, the guest must pay a membership fee to continue playing at UTC.

### Ball Machine Rental

Ball machine rental is \$5.00/session. The best time to use the ball machine is non-peak time periods.

## Clay Court Update

Based upon feedback from our membership, we decided that improving the playing surface of the clay courts would be a key objective this year. In order to achieve this objective, we invested in resurfacing and laser grading the clay courts. Initially, we experienced a number of challenges getting the new clay to bind with the existing clay. Through the combined efforts of our Clubhouse Manager (Zac) and the clay court contractors, we were able to rectify this problem.

A key requirement to maintain an optimal playing surface is to keep the clay courts watered. During the hot summer months it will be necessary to remove the clay courts from service for approximately 1 hour in the early afternoon (approximately 1:15 pm) and ½ hour in the evening (6:30pm – 7:00pm). This practice is consistent with the maintenance procedures being performed at other Tennis Clubs. By watering the courts twice daily, we should experience an improvement in the playability of the courts during the busy evening hours and eliminate evening dust bowls!

We recognize that we still have more work to do, but hope you are experiencing an improvement in the overall quality of the surface.

Here is how you can help improve the quality of the Clay Courts and surrounding areas:

- Please wear proper Tennis Shoes - Tread on Cross Trainers or Runners will actually tear up the clay surface
- Use the Tennie Two Step to Clean the Clay from your shoes - Yes, it has a funny name, but using the Tennie keeps the clay out of our clubhouse and off the Hard Court surface. Please notify the monitor if the Tennies are low on water.

- The Thumb Test - To determine if the courts are ready for play following a rain shower or watering, simply press your thumb into the clay near the baseline. If you can make an indentation with your thumb, the courts are not ready for play. If no indentation is visible then serve away!

## Wimbledon Singles Tournament

Please sign up now for our annual UTC Wimbledon singles tournament being held the weekend of July 20 – 22. We will be making every effort to accommodate entrants being able to meet their commitment to compete, so please do the same by keeping your calendar clear for match play if you enter any tournaments.

We will be trying a new format for the competitions, so that players will have enough energy for the Semi-Finals and Finals. All matches up to the Semi-Finals will be a 10 game pro-set with a regular (12 point) tie break to be played if the score reaches 9-9. The Semi-Finals and Finals will be the best of 3 sets.

## Year End Club Championships

### When:

The upcoming 2007 Year-End UTC Club Championship Tournaments will be take place as follows:

### Singles (Junior and Adult):

Thursday, August 23 to Sunday, August 26  
Entry Deadline is Monday, August 20

### Doubles (Junior and Adult):

Thursday, September 6 to Sunday, September 9  
Entry Deadline is Monday, September 3

### Mixed Doubles (Adult only):

Thursday, Sept. 13 to Sunday, September 16  
Entry Deadline is Monday, September 10

### Entry Fee:

Tournament Entry Fee is **\$2 per player for each event** entered and must be paid to the monitor prior to playing the first match. In addition, each player is required to provide **one new, unopened can of tournament grade tennis balls** for the match. One of these cans will be used for the match. The winner of the match receives the unopened can of balls for their next round, the loser of the match retains the used balls. (Examples of tournament grade balls are: Wilson Championship; Wilson US Open; Slazenger XL; Dunlop Fort; Penn).

### Scoring Format

All matches prior to the Semi-final and final matches are 10 game pro-set format. (First to 10 games with a difference of 2). Should the score reach 9-9, a regular tie break (12 point Tie-Break) will decide the winner. The Semi-Finals and Finals will be best of three sets with 12-point tie-breakers played at 6 games all of any set.

## Singles Ladders

So, when was the last time YOU played singles??

We have a great Singles Ladder for both Men and Women which started in early May and runs until the end of September. Each month, individuals challenge at least 2 players in their group of 6 to a singles ladder match. Rules are posted on the bulletin board, and at <http://www.unionvilletennisclub.com/ladderrules.html>

At the beginning of the month, a new ladder is established based on the last month's results, where the two players who scored the most points move "up" a group and the two who scored the least number of points, move "down" a group. Currently the Ladies June Ladder has 16 ladies and the Men's June Ladder has 38 men participating.

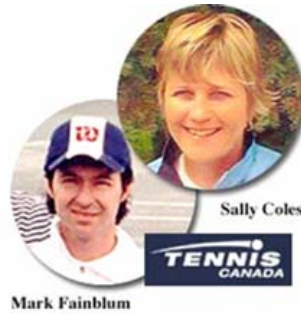
In the Women's Event, the draw size was 16 with prize money of \$400. Heidi Strassguertl was defeated by #1 Seed Kristina Goranskaya who in turn advanced to play against Sandra Simunic. It was a grueling match on Saturday between Sandra Sumunic and Kristina Goranskaya with the first set ending in a score of 7-6 (4) after which Sandra Sumunic had to retire due to heat exhaustion. Hodgson then competed against Kandice Belanger from Sudbury and lost 6-3, 6-2 advancing the unseeded Kandice Belanger to the finals against # 1 seed Kristina Goranskaya. On Sunday, in the Ladies Open UTC Finals, another hard fought women's match was played with the #1 seed Kristina Goranskaya barely defeating Kandice Belanger 1-6, 6-3, 7-6 (4).

# Pro's Corner



## Tips on How to Deal with Lobbing When Playing Doubles

There are three positions when playing doubles - two back; one up, one back; and two at the net. Today we are going to cover the most common form of lobbing in doubles, when two people are at the net. There are usually two types of lobs, an under spin lob (defensive) or a top spin lob (offensive).

An under spin lob is usually used when the player is barely able to reach for the ball or impacts the ball below the waist height. An under spin lob is hit with an open racquet face. A top spin lob is usually hit when contacted around waist height and is hit with a closed racquet face. It is much easier to receive an under spin lob since you have more time to run to the ball and the spin of the ball is not as challenging to hit as the top spin ball.

1. First thing you should do when seeing the lob is to start running backwards (cross over steps not shuffle steps).
2. You always want to keep your body behind the ball, you don't want the ball to be behind you.
3. When being lobbed your partner should be fairly close to you so that when you say "yours", your partner has time to run across the court and cover the lob. Be aware when you say "yours", don't move so that your partner can cut across. Once your partner has done that, then you take your partner's side of the court and depending on the quality of the shot that your partner will hit, you then go back to the net if it is a good shot or go back to the baseline if it is a defensive shot.
4. However if your partner says, "mine" then you both run back to the net, if your partner hit a good overhead or both run back if it is a poor overhead.

5. While you can not stop lobbers completely from lobbing, the best way to deal with them is to make sure that when both of you get to the net, you have made it difficult for your opponent to put up a quality lob by giving them less time to hit through good ball placement. You should hit the ball shorter when the opponent is far behind the base line or deep and hard when the opponent is inside the baseline. This will make it difficult to put up a quality lob for your opponents.

Otherwise don't be surprised that you keep getting lobbed. Good luck on the courts.

## Choosing the Right Junior Racquet

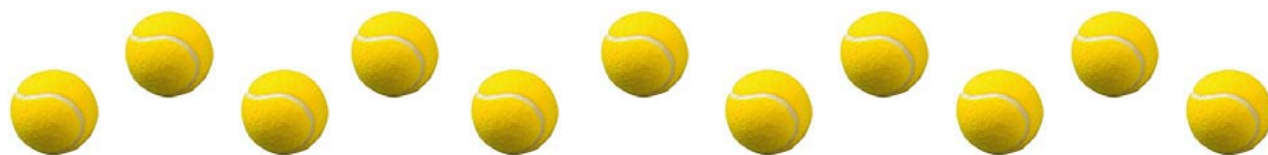

Your youngster wants to start playing tennis and you remember you still have your old racquet in the basement. Don't be tempted. Too often children are playing with the wrong size racquet and the wrong grip size for their size.

Start off with a much shorter racquet made specifically for the 5-7 year old and then progress to youth and adult rackets as they grow and develop.

Adult racquets come in different head sizes and grip sizes and should be comfortable enough for your child to control. Get some advice from a reputable sports store which specializes in tennis. Your child will not only thank you but will have more fun as they develop their tennis game.

# Unionville Tennis Club



## Code of Conduct:

1. To be assigned a court, members must register with the monitor on duty.
2. A shoe tag must be visible, otherwise you can be refused play.
3. Only proper tennis attire (including proper tennis shoes) will be allowed on the courts. (jeans, cut-offs, tank tops, casual shoes and sandals will not be permitted.)
4. Members must use the court walkways, gates and clubhouse for quick and quiet access to the courts.
5. Proper shoes are essential when using the clay courts. Use the “Tennie Two Step” to remove clay from your shoes each time after playing on the clay courts.
6. A maximum of 4 players are allowed on the court at one time. Spectators are not permitted on the court.
7. The following are not permitted in the club facilities:
  - Abusive language or behaviour
  - Spitting on the courts
  - Alcoholic beverages
  - Animals of any kind
  - Skateboards, scooters or roller blades
  - Cell phones are not to be used on the courts
8. Have fun and enjoy your game – remember tennis etiquette!
  - Talk quietly when standing near tennis courts in use.
  - To retrieve a ball from another court, wait until the players have completed a point to ask them to return it to you. To return a ball to another court, wait for a break in play on their court or roll the ball to the back of their court.
  - Be respectful of others.
